Piscataway's The Grove delivers amenity-rich living from BNE Real Estate, Sterling Properties

Developers BNE Real Estate Group and [Sterling Properties](#) said Wednesday their new luxury rental community in Middlesex County, The Grove at Piscataway, is officially open for leasing.

Centrally located in the heart of Piscataway township, minutes from [Rutgers University](#) and several major employment hubs, [The Grove](#) introduces a collection of new one- and two-bedroom rental residences surrounded by a host of indoor and outdoor amenities.

Grand opening rents start from the high \$1,800s. Limited-time incentives of up to two months free are currently available, based on a 26-month lease.

Residences feature open-concept layouts, plank flooring, in-unit washers and dryers, quartz countertops, full-height tiled backsplashes, built-in wine storage, and stainless-steel appliances. Select units also offer private outdoor space.

Building amenities include a fitness center with virtual training technology; a coworking lounge; children’s playroom; and a clubroom with a bar, billiards and lounge areas.

Twenty-four-hour onsite maintenance ensures residents are cared for around-the-clock, according to the developers, and packages can be delivered securely via Amazon package lockers. The pet-friendly community also features a dog spa. Outside, a resort-style pool terrace offers an outdoor bar, BBQ grills, and surrounding lounge areas.

Located less than a mile from an entrance to Route 287, the highway connects to the Garden State Parkway; New Jersey Turnpike; and Routes 1, 18, 22 and 78. Rutgers’ Busch and Livingston campuses are both about 3 miles away.
